Robert Amler. M.D., M.B.A., dean of the School of Health Sciences and Practice and vice president for government affairs, and Sherlita Amler, M.D., M.S., clinical associate professor of pediatrics, adjunct professor of public health and senior fellow in the Center for Disaster Medicine, were speakers at a virtual assembly of Sound Shore residents about latest COVID-19 developments at the Larchmont-Mamaroneck Local Summit, "Navigating the COVID Vaccine and the Effect on Our Community," on November 9. The event included a lively Q&A session that covered vaccine boosters, persistence of masking recommendations, travel safety and the transient quality of immunity from natural COVID-19 infection.

On November 9, George W.
