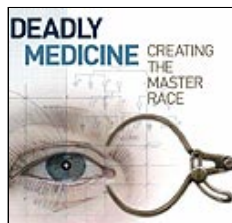
Director's Greeting

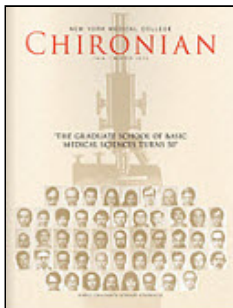

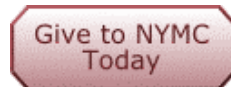
