NYMC Honors Historic Partnership with NYC Health + Hospitals/Metropolitan During Plaque Dedication Ceremony



Leadership from NYMC, Met and representatives from the 23rd Precinct joined to commemorate the plaque which was recently restored by **Edward C. Halperin, M.D., M.A.**, fourth from right, chancellor and chief executive officer, and **Nicholas Webb, MSIS**, fourth from left, archivist and digital preservation librarian.
