# The Inaugural Dr. Melvin H. Amler Prize for Innovation to be Announced

Jonathan V. Pascale, a fifth-year Ph.D. student, was named the inaugural recipient of the *Melvin H. Amler Prize for Innovation* for his research illuminating the importance of the vasoactive eicosanoid, 20hydroxyeicosatetraenoic acid (20-HETE) and its receptor GPR75 at the Innovation and Entrepreneurship in



the Biomedical Space Conference, on September 15. 20-HETE and its receptor are implicated across a variety of pathologies including cancer, hypertension, diabetes and most recently, obesity. The award was established in honor of the late Melvin H. Amler, M.S., D.D.S., a National
