A WORD FROM THE LAW LIBRARY - EXITS CLOSED DUE TO LIBRARY EXPANSION

Due to library expansion several important changes are being made to entrances and exits in the building. The purpose of these changes is to provide security and control for all library areas.

The Library Security Desk is being relocated to a new position near the mailroom. A front door will be installed at this new formal Library Entrance. All exits and entrances within the library will be secured by alarm crash bars and will only serve as emergency exits.
