

On rare occasion it can truly be said of an individual and an institution that they embody and personify each other to the degree that one can no longer tell where one begins and the other ends.


In dedicating our yearbook, the Class of 1984 has chosen to honor just such a person - the founder and father of Touro College - Dr. Bernard Lander.

A consummate sociologist; a brilliant Torah scholar; a noted communal leader; a skilled educator - his entire accomplishment - blessed life was but a prelude to his audacious achievement in remaking the face of American Higher Education by creating Touro College. He sensed a need and a potential at the very moment when so many Jewish Americans, were despairing of the college experience as a vehicle for constructive social change.

The past thirteen years and indeed the many preceding years when he nurtured his then lonely dream - were replete with trying moments when a lesser person would have surrendered to the apparently self-evident. That Touro College has not only survived, but has flourished, is telling tribute to the quality of his leadership and the magnitude of his perseverance.

Even as Touro College has expanded on virtually every educational frontier we, the students of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, have remained his first concern and first love.


If we, as so many before us, have benefitted from these years at Touro College it is because he dared to create a unique institution where a student can receive a superb secular education while growing in Torah values and Jewish knowledge. For this and for his tireless labors to ensure the survival and success of Touro College we thankfully dedicate this 1984 College Yearbook to our teacher, and President, Dr. Bernard Lander.



Thirteen years ago a college was founded with the sole intent of enabling Jewish college aged youth to combine secular and Judaic Studies. Starting small, with only thirty-six men, Touro College soon developed into a major institution of higher education.

The college opened a Women's Division and a Physicians Assistant's Program in 1973. Two years later the School of General Studies was started. But this was only the beginning. In 1979 the Herzliah Jewish Teachers Seminary became a part of Touro; in 1980 the medical records administration program was instituted and the Touro Law School was launched. Last year, the Bio-medical Program in conjunction with the Technion Medical School of Haifa (Israel) was opened. These programs have made Touro College one of the finest Liberal Arts Colleges in the East. Touro has become the choice for the youth of today, who have become disenchanted with the typical college milieu. Touro allows students to learn more about themselves and their culture while intergrating this knowledge into the world as a whole.

Thirteen is a very significant number in Jewish life. There are thirteen attributes of G-d, the Ramban's thirteen principles of faith and thirteen is the time of a boy's Bar Mitzvah. In this Touro's thirteenth year, we have achieved an important goal, Bar Mitzvah. We have sought to better understand Hashem and his ways through our Torah studies but we are still striving and must continue to strive for one thing, the coming of Mashiach. We believe with perfect faith that by taking the Torah we have learned, out with us into this secular world that we can achieve this coveted goal. We are grateful to Touro, for providing us with an education which has prepared us for careers and has helped us develop our identity as committed Jews.



Dear Graduates:

The quality of a college or university rests upon the quality of its students. Touro can never be any better than you are.

We are fortunate in having had you as students during your college years. Many of you have excelled in your studies and in your contributions to student life. If we can judge by the record of your predecessors, you can look forward to successful careers and professional lives.
