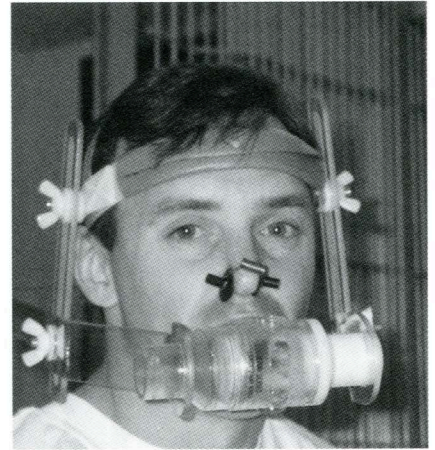
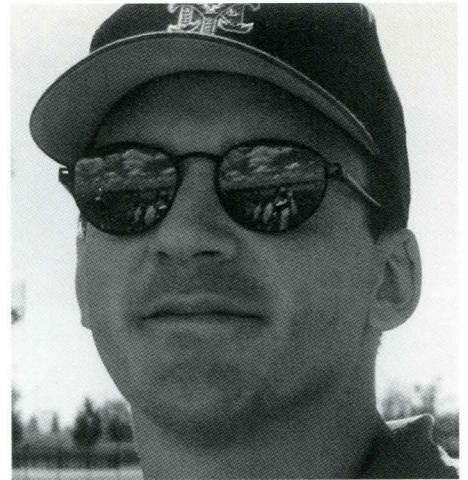




## TRIBUTE TO CHRIS COOK
